PROJECT UPDATES: COORDINATION MEETINGS AND NEXT MILESTONES – WINGS CONTINUE TO FLY AND MOVE ON

Following the initial partner meeting held on 21 October 2024, consortium members reconvened for two follow-up coordination meetings on 20 January 2025 and 17 March 2025. These meetings marked key moments in advancing the project's implementation and refining its strategic components.

During the 20 January 2025 meeting, partners collaboratively defined the guidelines for the production of the project handbook in national languages—German, Polish, Czech, and Turkish. In addition, responsibilities were allocated for the development of the final version in Ukrainian, aimed specifically at end users.



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A comprehensive review of the Quality Plan, Sustainability Plan, Risk Management Plan, and Dissemination Plan was also conducted, with inputs from representatives of all participating organizations. Partners further agreed to convene again in March for an online follow-up and began planning for upcoming project milestones. It was agreed that the next major in-person meeting would take place in Türkiye on 5–6 June 2025, followed by a subsequent face-to-face meeting in Prague in 2026. All other interim meetings related to project milestones will be held in virtual format. The session concluded with a discussion on the project website and dissemination campaign, including strategies for social media outreach via Facebook, LinkedIn, and X (formerly Twitter).



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The subsequent online coordination meeting on 17 March 2025 focused on the drafting of the multilingual project handbooks. The primary version will be produced in English, with translations into each partner's national language and a final version in Ukrainian. To support this multilingual effort, several digital translation tools—including ChatGPT, DeepL, Canvas, and others—were reviewed and assessed by participating teams.

A central component of the meeting was the presentation and finalization of the four core strategic documents: the Quality Plan, Sustainability Plan, Risk Management Plan, and Dissemination Plan—ensuring the solidification of the overall project management framework. The final part of the meeting addressed digital visibility, with updates shared on the website and digital dissemination strategies.



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Partners now look forward to the upcoming face-to-face meeting in Kastamonu, Türkiye, on 5–6 June 2025, which will mark a key opportunity to consolidate the progress achieved thus far and continue building strong collaboration toward the project's next phases.
