# **PROJECT UPDATES: COMPLETION OF WP<sub>2</sub> AND PROGRESS ON WP<sub>3</sub>**

Since the online coordination meeting on 17 March 2025, the WINGS partnership has made significant strides in advancing the project's core objectives.

Following months of collaborative work, partners have successfully finalised the Guidebook “Rise Up: Career Development Strategies for Migrant Women” in all required national languages—German, Polish, Czech, Turkish—as well as in Ukrainian. This milestone marks the completion of Work Package 2 (WP<sub>2</sub>) and represents the first major project output. The guidebook will soon be published on all partners' websites, making it accessible to women forced migrants from Ukraine across the participating countries.

# **PLAYING THE GROUNDWORK FOR WP<sub>3</sub> – TRAINING MATERIALS DEVELOPMENT**

With WP2 completed, the consortium has turned its focus to Work Package 3 (WP3)—the development of the Comprehensive Integration Learning Programme (CILP) titled “Leap Forward: Women’s Career Transformation.”

During the transnational meeting in Kastamonu (5–6 June 2025), partners agreed on a clear division of tasks for creating the training materials. Detailed guidelines for WP3 have now been prepared, outlining content areas, responsibilities, and deadlines. The materials will cover ten thematic modules, with contributions from all partners, and will be finalised by 30 November 2025.

- The Dissemination – The publication and promotion of the multilingual Guidebook will be carried out via the project's website, EPALE platform, and social media channels (Facebook, LinkedIn, X).
- Training Materials Production – Partners will work intensively over the coming months to finalise the WP3 content in line with the agreed guidelines.
- Evaluation and Review – Upon completion, the training resources will undergo partner review before piloting.
